Seed Commons is cooperatively and collectively governed by a body of 35 Peer member funds across the U.S.

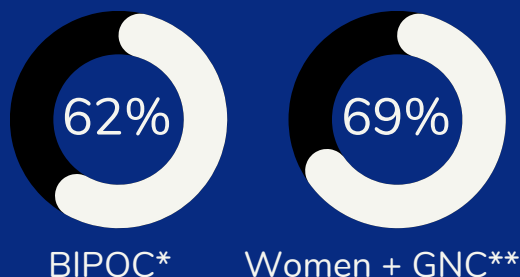
### Primary Stakeholders

Folks from marginalized groups and low-income communities who have historically been underrepresented in business ownership in the capitalist economy.

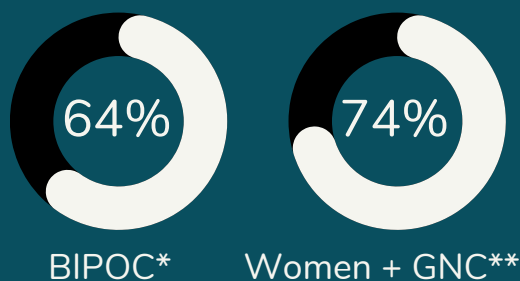
### Seed Commons Flagship Capital Pool and THRIVE Capital Pool

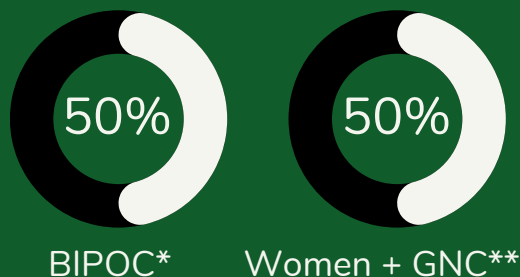

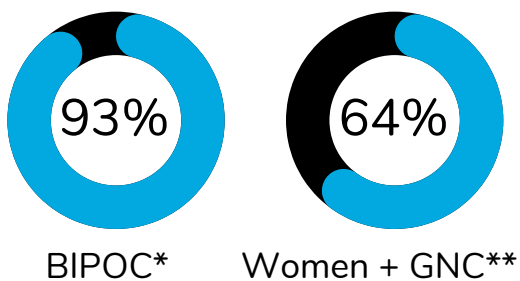
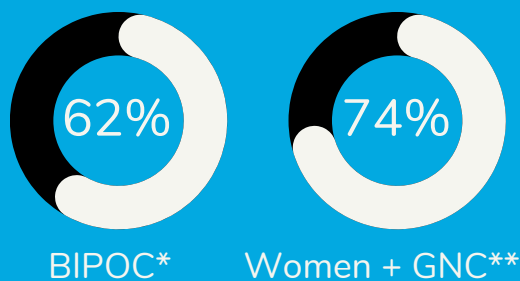
